
Registration

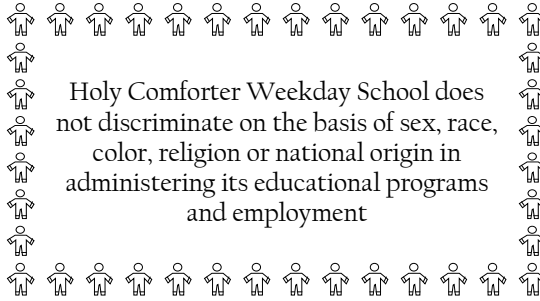
Registration for the Fall opens in February. Church members currently enrolled in our program are permitted to register the first week. The following week registration is opened to families currently enrolled that are non-church members. Church members NOT currently enrolled are then given the opportunity to register and finally registration is open to the general public.

At the time of application, a non-refundable registration fee will be collected. Registration for currently enrolled families and church members is \$85 for the first child and \$80 for each additional child. Registration for the general public is \$100. Additionally, in May of the year you register, one month's tuition (for the month of May of the year for which you are registering) will be debited from your account*.

Both of these fees are non-refundable. If these fees are not paid by the end of the registration period the space will be released.

There is an additional \$120 activity fee for 3's & 4's and \$50 for 1's & 2's which covers our in-house enrichment programs including music, science and storytelling. The fee for 3's & 4's is paid in two installments \$60 with registration and \$60 due September 11th. Activity fee for 1's & 2's is due with registration.

* If enrolling your child after the Spring registration period, both the registration fee and May tuition will be due with your child's application.
